# Exciting product debuts, fresh inspiration await trade buyers from 12 – 14 November at Expo City's DEC

**DUBAI, United Arab Emirates, 12<sup>th</sup> August 2024** – Trade buyers from across the globe will uncover a wealth of high-quality B2B sourcing opportunities, inspiring events and the latest in industry-related technologies at one of the world's premier jewellery marketplaces – Jewellery, Gem & Technology in Dubai (JGTD).

Jointly organised by Informa Markets Jewellery and Italian Exhibition Group SpA (IEG), JGTD is back for its third edition from 12 to 14 November in Halls 1 & 2 South of the Dubai Exhibition Centre (DEC) in Expo City.

The fair is strategically timed to meet the sourcing requirements of B2B buyers.

"November's JGT in Dubai is the place to be, scheduled on the international calendar to meet the needs of the regional market and replenish diamond, gem and gold jewellery stock with a premium sourcing event. Opportunities within the industry will multiply, thanks also to other events taking place in The City of Gold' during the same week. Partnering with major local institutions strengthens the B2B presence of the show in this commercial hub, serving an array of strong economies and emerging markets seeking select providers to build and foster their own jewellery and gem businesses," commented **Marco Carniello**, Chief Business Officer at IEG. "At JGTD, attendees will meet leading industry players and benefit from numerous business, training and networking opportunities. This includes gaining a comprehensive view of jewellery design and luxury consumer trends."

JGTD will present a diverse array of products including fine jewellery, loose diamonds, coloured gemstones, lab-grown diamonds, jewellery mountings, equipment and tools, and manufacturing technologies, among others. Further enhancing buyers' procurement opportunities are 10+ neighbourhoods, inclusive of five new country pavilions featuring suppliers from China, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Singapore and the US. Top show floor destinations such as the Hong Kong, India and Italy sections will also be returning to the JGTD spotlight.

Moreover, JGTD will run concurrently with Dubai Diamond Week, scheduled for 11 to 15 November. Presented by DMCC, this event will feature the seventh edition of the Dubai Diamond Conference on 11 November and the Kimberley Process Plenary Session from 12 to 15 November.



Limited, known for their significant inventory of top-quality IF to I2 diamonds in diameters ranging from 0.90mm to 4.30mm, to name a few.




